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Login and start

Go to <https://greenscreenbox.app>
Log in with a token or an account.

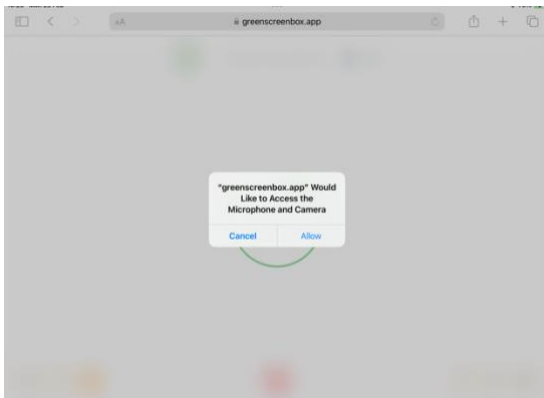


You receive a token when purchasing a Greenscreenbox, or create a free trial account via <https://greenscreenbox.app/register>.

Tap on **Start**.









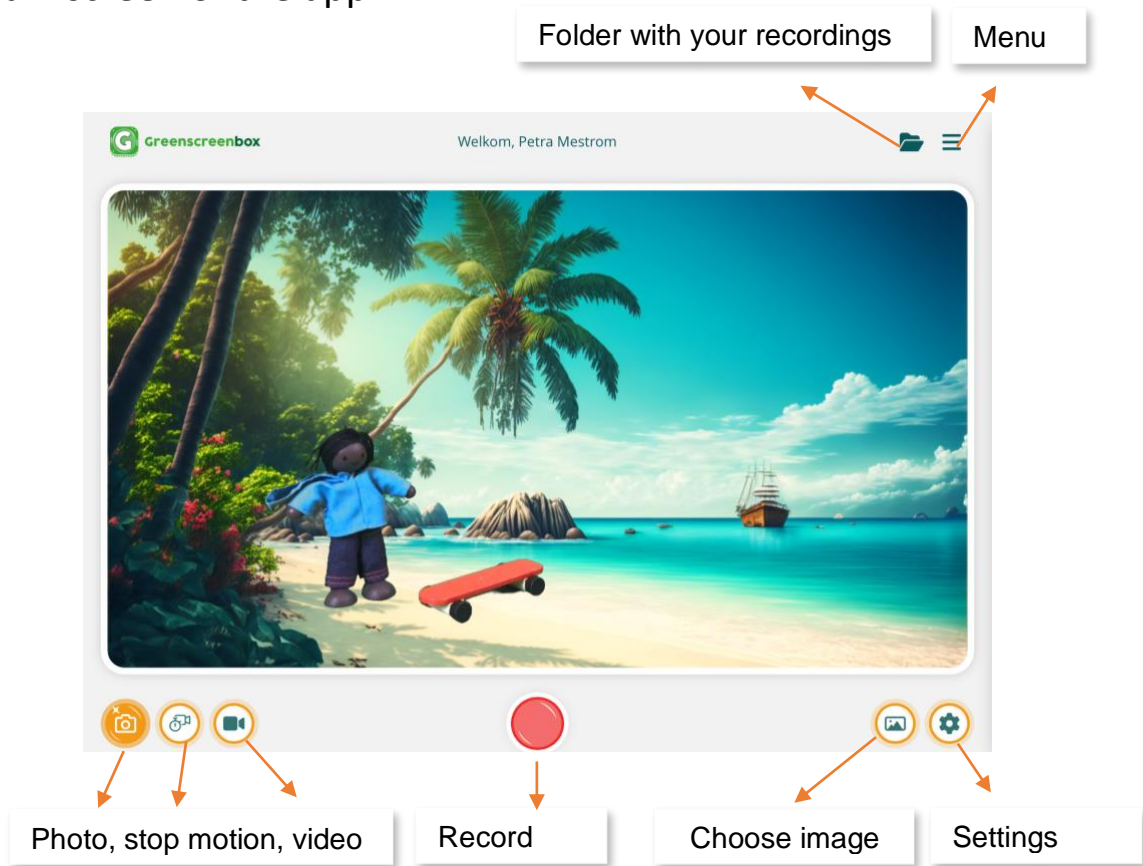
Using the app for the first time

The first time, the app guides you through the steps. In subsequent uses, the app opens directly to the [main screen](#).

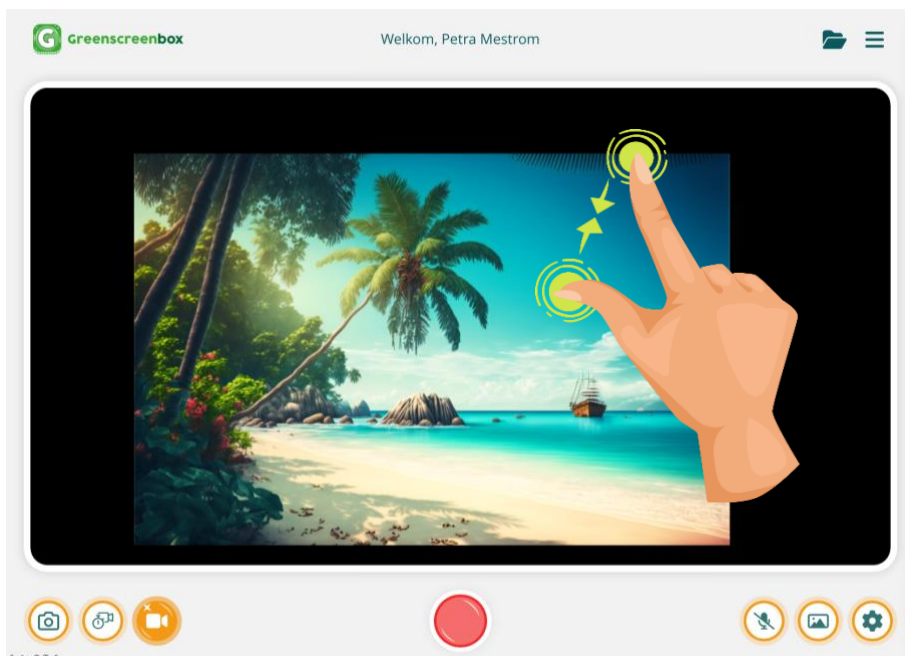
<p>Tap on Choose Image.</p> 	<p>Select an image form the library. The image loads immediately.</p> <p>Or tap on Choose your own image.</p> 
<p>Tap on Photo Library and select the photo you want to use.</p> 	<p>Choose Back camera.</p> <p>Or select the webcam if you are using one.</p> 
<p>The app displays the default settings for filtering the green color of the Greenscreenbox.</p> <p>Use the circles to (optionally) fine-tune further:</p> <p>Amount: set how much you want to key-out. Blur: use this to blur small imperfections. Color: adjust the color intensity.</p> <p>Tap the green checkmark to save the settings and go tot he main screen of the app.</p>	



The main screen of the app



By pinching or spreading with two fingers, you can zoom in or out on the background.



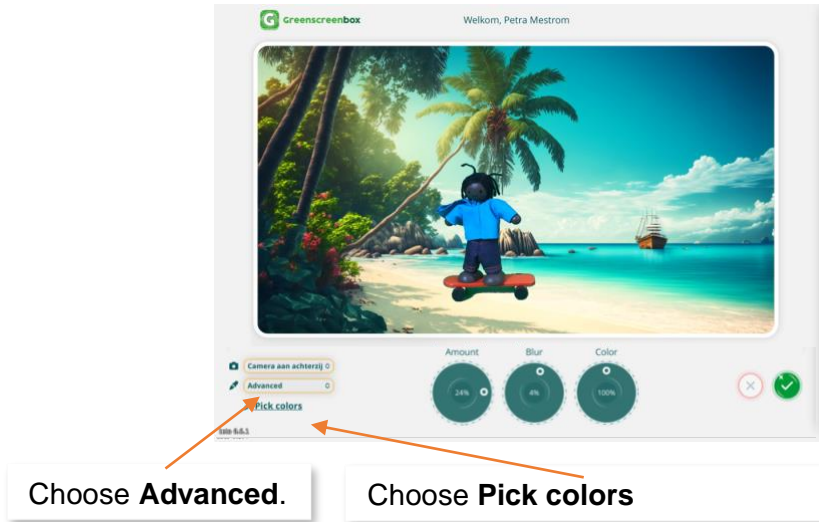
Don't have a touchscreen? Use the **S-key + move the mouse to the left/right.**



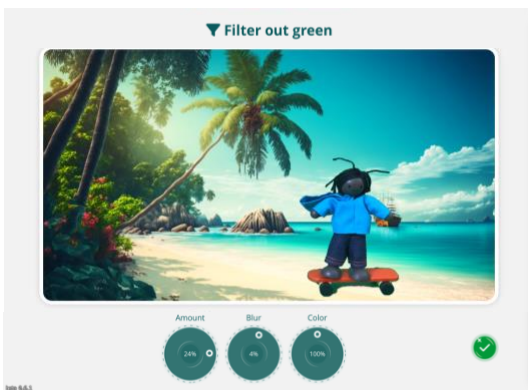
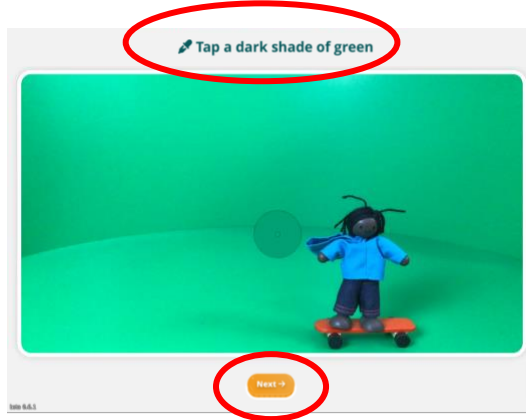
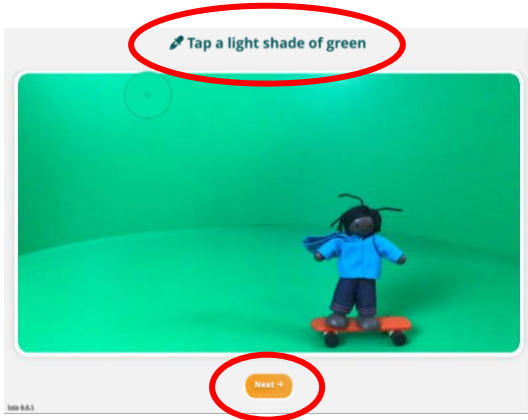
Settings – advanced

During the startup of the app, you've used the default settings. This provides a fairly decent result, suitable for beginners and young children.

Do you want a better result? That's possible! Tap on the settings wheel in the main screen.



Follow the steps of the app and choose which green colors should be keyed out.



Use the circles to (optionally) finetune further:

Amount: set how much you want to key-out.

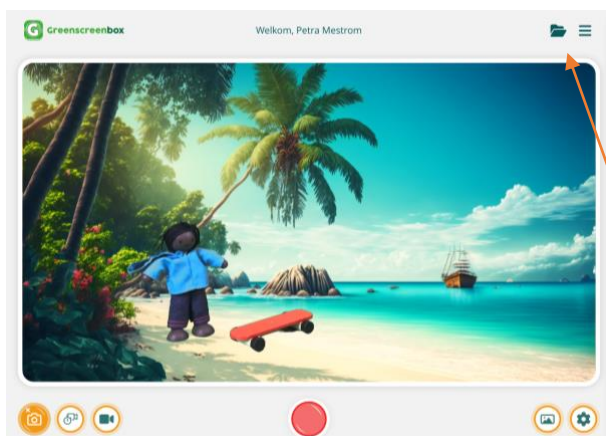
Blur: use this to blur small imperfections.

Color: adjust the color intensity.

Tap the green checkmark to save the settings and go to the main screen of the app.



Take a photo

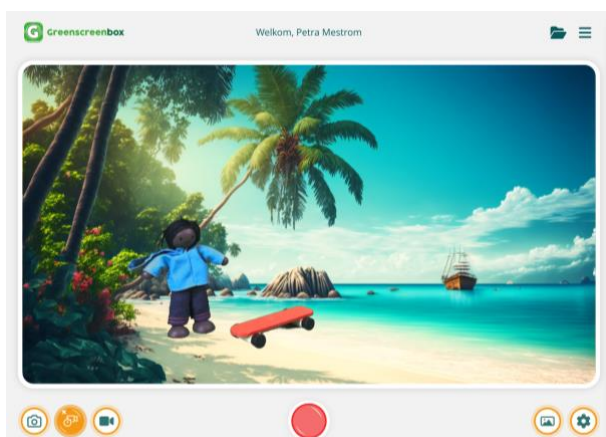


1. Tap the photo camera.

2. Tap the red button.

3. Your photo is saved in this folder.

Create a stop motion

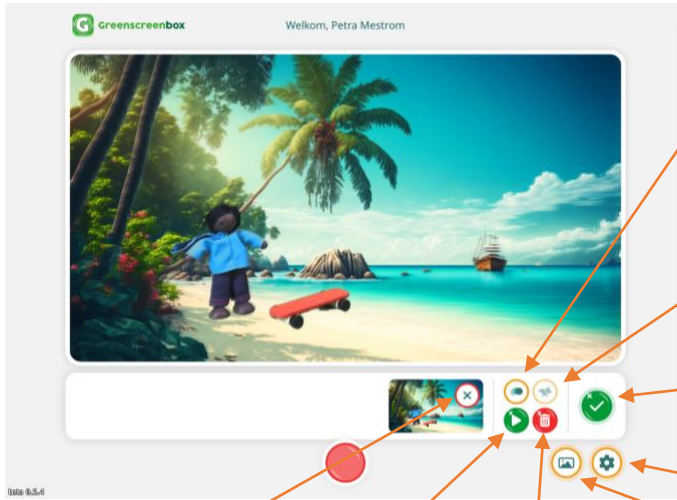


1. Tap the stop motion camera.

2. Press the red button to take the first photo



After taking your first photo, you will enter this screen. Below, we will explain the various functions:



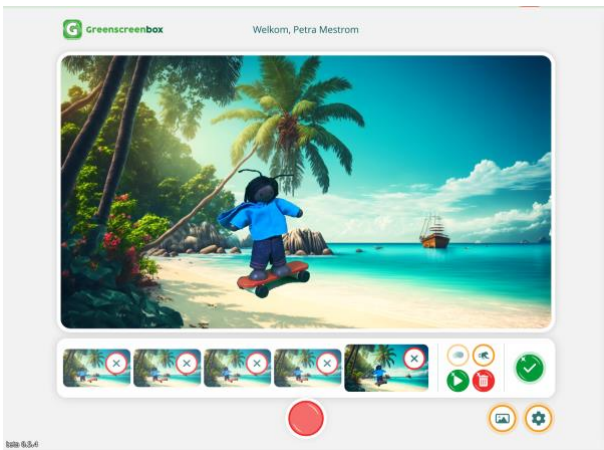
Ghost function: choose whether you want to see the previous photo or not when taking a new photo. This helps you determine how much a figure has moved compared to the previous photo.

Speed: how fast should the photos be played in the stop motion?

Save your stop motion.

Tap the cross to remove an incorrect photo from your stop motion.	Preview your stop motion film.	Remove stop motion.	Change background.	Settings.
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After taking the first photo, move your object a bit and tap on the red record button again. Repeat this until you feel you have taken enough photos.



After taking multiple photos, you will see a row of photos. You can delete an incorrect photo by tapping on the cross of that photo.

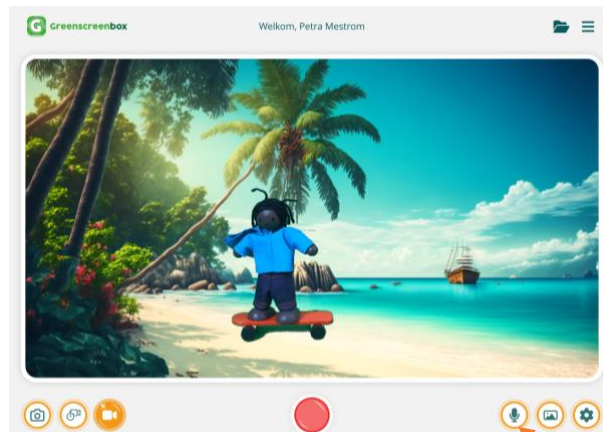
Tip: you can change your background in between and then continue with your stop motion.

Are you finished? Tap the green checkmark on the right side. Your stop motion will be saved in the folder.

You cannot edit the stop motion further once it has been saved.



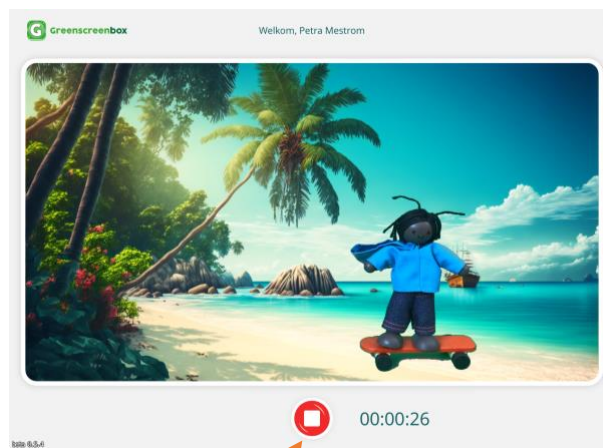
Record a movie



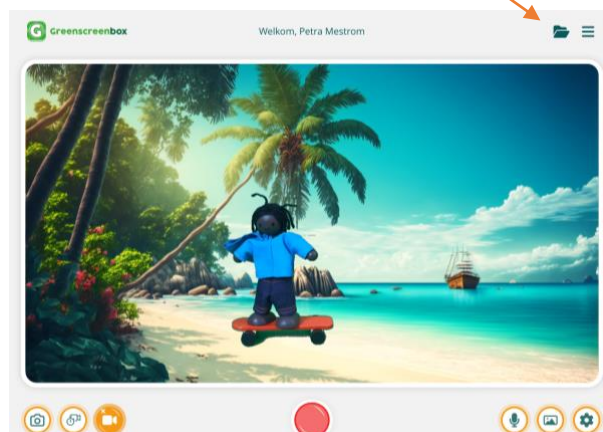
1. Tap the film camera.

2. Record

(Mute the microphone if you don't want to record sound.)



3. Tap the square to stop recording.
4. Your movie will be saved in this folder.

Where are the recordings I make stored?

Recordings you make are temporarily stored in the app folder on your own device. They are not stored in your account or on our servers. Go to the folder at the top right of the app's main screen. Tap on the download icon to download your recording and save it to your device.

How can I edit the scenes I've created?

If you want to further edit the recordings you have made, use one of the many video editing tools available. For iOS, you can use the free iMovie. Some excellent free web-based tools are Canva or Clipchamp.
